# **♦ AGENCY UPDATES**

#### NSF

- As of 9/26/16, NSF will perform automated compliance improvements for proposals submitted via FastLane (not S2S)
  - Combined text of Project Summary text boxes (or pdf attachment if special characters) does not exceed one page
    - See the <u>Proposal & Award Policies and Procedures Guide</u> (PAPPG), Chapter II.C.2.b, for further information.
  - Error Messages for the following:
    - Project Summary text exceeds one page limit
    - Project Summary text entered **and** Project Summary with special characters is also uploaded

# **♦ AGENCY UPDATES**

#### NIH \*

- NIH Operates Under a Continuing Resolution (NOT-OD-17-001)
  - Continues government operations through December 9, 2016 at 99.504% of the FY 2016 enacted level.
  - NIH will issue non-competing research grant awards at a level below that indicated on the most recent Notice of Award (generally up to 90% of the previously committed level).
  - Upward adjustments to awarded levels will be considered after FY 2017 appropriations are enacted, but NIH expects institutions to monitor their expenditures carefully during this period.
  - Salary limitation set at Executive Level II of the Federal Pay Scale (\$185,100)(see NOT-OD-16-059) and the Ruth L. Kirschstein National Research Service Award stipend levels and tuition/fees (see NOT-OD-16-062) are still in effect.

# **♦ AGENCY UPDATES**

#### NIH \*

- \*Optional\* Electronic Submission Method to Request to Submit An Unsolicited Application That Will Exceed \$500,000 In Direct Costs (NOT-OD-17-005)
  - Requests to submit an unsolicited application that will exceed \$500,000 in direct costs will now have an option to submit this request electronically through eRA Commons, under a new **Prior Approval Module**.
  - After initial communication with the NIH, a NIH Program Officer (PO) may open up a request form for the Principal Investigator (PI) in eRA Commons. The PI will complete the form and submit it back to the initiating PO for review.
  - Instructions for how to use this new system can be found in the **Prior Approval User Guide**.
  - For more information on the policy, see section 2.3.7.2 of the NIH Grants Policy Statement.
