NIST Launches New iEdison System for Reporting Federally Funded Inventions:

- NIH system shut down on Aug. 2, 2022.
- The updated iEdison system includes a modernized user interface.
- New messaging features make it easier to communicate with funding agencies.
- Expanded application programming interface (API) that will allow organizations to automate some reporting tasks.
- Integrated with information systems at the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office for easier updating of patent information.

## Ensuring Free, Immediate, & Equitable Access to Federally Funded Research:

- Federal agencies must update their public access policies ASAP, and no later than December 31, 2025, to make publications and their supporting data resulting from federally funded research publicly accessible without an embargo on their free and public release
- Inside Higher Ed article:

## Department of Energy Update:

- Beginning in FY 2023, all DOE Office of Science FOAs and DOE National Lab
   Announcements and other funding solicitations will require applicants to submit a
   Promoting Inclusive and Equitable Research (PIER) Plan as an appendix to their
   proposal narrative.
- PIER Plans should describe the activities and strategies applicants will incorporate
  to promote diversity, equity, inclusion, and accessibility in their research projects.
- PIER Plans will be evaluated as part of the merit review process and will be used to inform funding decisions.

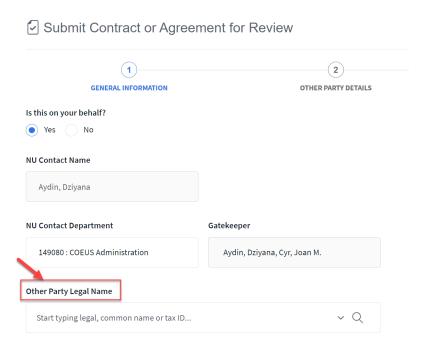

### What is the role of each group?

- The Office of Academic Research (OARS) is primarily responsible for laboratory safety, both research and academic, including oversight and training related to the University's chemical, biological, and radiation safety programs.
- The Environmental Compliance and Occupational Safety (ECOS) office, embedded with Facilities, is responsible for occupational safety and environmental compliance associated with campus building operations/maintenance, grounds management, construction, and renovation.
- The Safety Leadership Council (SLC) is a representative governing body providing informed guidance, advice, and recommendations on policy, program and compliance matters related to safety to university leadership and the campus community at large.



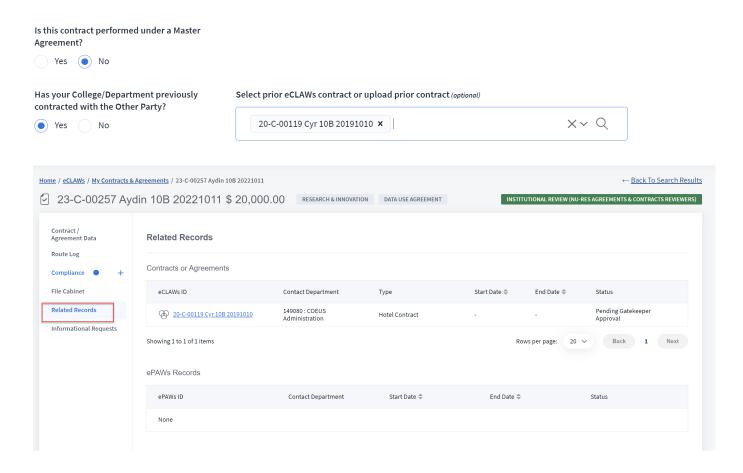
## Submitting Contract or Agreement for Review

# **NU-RES Finance Updates**

- Payroll certifications will go out this week
- SNAP reports have been revised, IDC projections have been corrected to account for subcontract >\$25K
- New set up process changes
  - RF included in the congrats email, will request budget if needed
  - Working through AOS requests, emails may come through as "completed"
  - Emails that go out for new accounts and continuations will be revised





## Timeline

#### **Prior Fiscal Year**

#### July - June

- Project expenditures are monitored on a monthly basis.
- Payroll adjustments and corrections are made via PDCs throughout the fiscal year.

#### **Current Fiscal Year**

Final round of payroll

#### July - September

corrections or adjustments for prior FY are identified and PDCs are processed.

#### October

- Business Day 6-7: Research Payroll Certification Reports are sent to department contacts, following September financial close.
- Department contacts distribute certification reports to PI/Delegate.
- PIs certify reports. If revisions are needed, PDCs are processed and revisions are noted.
- Departments return completed certifications to NU-RES Finance.

#### November

- 11/1: Completed certifications due to NU-RES Finance.
- Payroll Certification period is closed.

Overdue Reports:

11/8: escalate to Deans

11/15: escalate to Provost
