New QuickCard

- SOP for Overdue Programmatic Reports Submitted Directly by Principal Investigator (available <u>online</u>)
 - Outlines the standard operating procedure for NU-RES in monitoring overdue programmatic reports submitted directly to the funding agency by the PI (i.e., progress reports that do not require institution signature).
 - For NSF: Colleges will receive monthly report listing programmatic reports due within ninety (90) days or that are overdue.
 - Reports not submitted at least 15 days prior to due date or past due the transaction will be logged on the NU-RES RA tracking log and assigned to the relevant GO in NU-RES.
 - Other funding agencies: The overdue report transaction will be logged on the tracking log and assigned to the relevant GO in NU-RES.

• Escalation process includes ADR (2 weeks) and VPRA (30 days or more). For the astern University Escarch Enterprise Services

New QuickCard

- GEM Fellowship Process (available <u>online</u>)
 - Various Northeastern colleges accept GEM Fellows. The fellowship contract with GEM is a binding document that commits Northeastern to certain terms and conditions, as such NU-RES serves as the University's signing official on all Gem Fellowship contracts.
 - Employer sponsored: complete form, submit eCLAWS and ePAWS records.
 - University internal funding only: complete form, submit \$0 eCLAWS and ePAWS records.
 - If NU is providing internal funds for stipend and/or tuition a completed cost share form, which includes the appropriate department account number, must be uploaded to the ePaws record.





NIH Updates:

- <u>NOT-OD-23-066</u>: Extending the Special Exception to the NIH/AHRQ/NIOSH Post-Submission Material Policy During the COVID-19 Pandemic: August/October 2023 Councils
 - Applications submitted under all activity codes for August/October 2023 Council rounds (beginning with submissions for January 25, 2023 due date), a one-page update with preliminary data as post-submission materials will be accepted, ONLY if FOA used for submission allowed preliminary data in the application.
 - Deadline for submitting all post-submission materials, including preliminary data, will be 30 days before the study section meeting, unless specified otherwise in the FOA.
 - Because applications for emergency competitive revisions and urgent competitive revisions undergo expedited review, post-submission materials will not be accepted for those applications.

NU-RES Compliance Updates

NSF Safe & Inclusive Working Environments for Off-campus or Off-site Research that is effective with the <u>2023 PAPPG</u> (Chapter II.E.9) (Slide 1 of 2)

- New checkbox on the proposal cover page to identify off-site research
- Off-site = field work, i.e., collecting water samples on a boat
- AOR must certify that the institution has a plan in place to address unwelcome and/or abusive conduct, as well as the institution's plans to foster a supportive environment
- Faculty performing off-site research must have a specific plan and this plan MUST be disseminated to the project team prior to departure
- Unless specified in the FOA, the plan should **not** be included in the proposal, but NSF does have the right to request the plan





NU-RES Compliance Updates

NSF Off-site Policy (Chapter II.E.9) (slide 2 of 2)

- University's <u>code of ethical conduct</u> is not location specific and applies to every member of the community regardless of physical location
- NU-RES will support the community in complying with this plan through:
 - NU-RES will add language to the AOS set up email reminding PI of applicability and to disseminate plan prior to leaving for off-site work
 - Additional training for college admins during our 2023 workshop day (discussed in the Upcoming Events slide)
 - Develop a webpage with resources, including plan templates for faculty
 - We strongly recommend faculty attend our upcoming training on conflict management in partnership with the Ombuds Office
 - •_Mentorship RECR is in development, and will include working off-site
