National Institutes of Health (NIH):

• NOT-HS-25-006: New AHRQ "FORMS-I" Grant Application Forms and Instructions Coming for Due Dates on or after January 25, 2025

If your intended due date is?	You must use
 On or before January 24, 2025, including: Applications submitted for due dates on or before January 24, 2025 	FORMS-H application package
 On or after January 25, 2025, including: Applications submitted for due dates on or after January 25, 2025 All application types (New, Resubmission, Renewal, Revision) Applications submitted early for intended due dates on or after January 25, 2025 	FORMS-I application package



Off Campus Rate:

The off-campus rate is applicable to all extramurally funded sponsored activities where documentation in proposal/award materials confirms:

- There are multiple performance sites and the Preponderance of the Time and Effort related to the
 extramurally funded sponsored activity is conducted at a site that is not Northeastern owned or
 leased; and
- The cost of the leased or rented space is included as a direct cost in the project budget and is paid
 as a direct cost by the funding agency.

Off Campus Rate (cont'd):

Exceptions related to Off Campus rate guidance are possible.

- 1. Regardless of place of performance, a funding agency stipulates an F&A rate and provides written documentation of their indirect cost policy statement that prohibits the University's recovery of the applicable federal F&A rate; or
- 2. The PI may request an exception to this guidance by submitting a written request to their college's Associate Dean for Research/ Finance requesting under-recovery of the allowable, applicable F&A costs. College-level approvals to forego recovery of allowable indirect costs must be attached to ePAWS proposal records at the time the proposal is routed to NU-RES for review.
- 3. The Northeastern owned or paid-for (e.g. leased) facility is not included in the effective federally negotiated rate agreement (e.g., foreign Northeastern campus).
- Approved reduced rates that do not meet the Off Campus qualifications should be referred to as "reduced rate" in the budget justification and/or proposal.

- DOE Research Security Training Requirements for all R&D Financial Assistance Awards
 - o The purpose of the <u>DOE FAL</u> **(FAL 2025-02)** is to provide information and guidance regarding DOE's implementation of research security training requirements for covered individuals listed on financial assistance applications and for the organizations applying for such an award, per Section 10634 of the CHIPS & Science Act.
 - Covered individuals must certify that they have "completed within one year of such application research security training that meets the guidelines [described in the Act]".
 - DOE interprets this as the 12 months immediately preceding the application date.



DOE Covered Indvidual Definition

- Covered Individual means an individual who (a) contributes in a substantive, meaningful way to the development or execution of the scope of work of a project funded by DOE or proposed for funding by DOE, and (b) is designated as a covered individual by DOE.
- At a minimum, DOE designates as covered individuals any principal investigator (PI); project director (PD); co-principal investigator (Co-PI); co-project director (Co-PD); project manager; and any individual regardless of title that is functionally performing as a PI, PD, Co-PI, Co-PD, or project manager.





- DOE Research Security Training Requirement
 - Optional until May 1, 2025 mandatory thereafter
 - Covered individuals listed on applications under this funding opportunity are required to certify that they have taken research security training
 - New covered individuals at the recipient and subrecipient levels added to the project must certify that they have completed the training within 30 calendar days of the individual joining the project.
 - Hard stop: RS training will need to be completed before a DOE proposal is submitted!
 - <u>4 NSF funded RS training modules</u> meet the requirement
 - We highly encourage PIs with active DOE awards and those submitting DOE proposals to fulfill this requirement now.
 - Communications will be made directly to PIs with DOE awards and those submitting DOE awards in addition to a broader communication to the Northeastern research community



- Northeastern Research Security Training Program
 - Training modules published to and accessible in Workday Learning
 - Allows for trainings to be assigned and track attendance
 - Set and send reminders
 - 3 short, internally developed modules that will cover;
 - Export Controls
 - Covered Defense Information (CDI)
 - International Travel
 - 4 NSF developed modules that cover;
 - What is Research Security?
 - Disclosure
 - Manage and Mitigate Risk
 - International Collaboration
 - 1 condensed version of the NSF modules developed by University of Michigan, Stanford, Ohio State, and Duke



- DOE Digital Persistent Identifier or Persistent Identifier (DPI/PID)
 Requirements for all R&D Financial Assistance Awards
 - o The purpose of the <u>DOE FAL</u> (FAL 2024-05) is to provide information and guidance regarding DOE's implementation of the digital persistent identifier requirements included in NSPM-33, the NSPM-33 Implementation Guidance, the OSTP Public Access Memo, the DOE Public Access Plan, and the Policy Regarding Use of Common Disclosure Forms.





- Requirements for Applicants and Recipients
 - Applicants must ensure than any individuals who meet both conditions below obtain a DPI/PID for themselves that meets the common/core standards specified in the NSPM-33 Implementation Guidance or successor guidance (e.g., ORCID ID).
 - 1. Individual is listed within financial assistance applications that will fund R&D activities, or technical assistance to support R&D activities; and
 - 2. Individual is required to submit Biographical Sketch and/or Current and Pending (Other)
 Support disclosure.
 - The DPI/PID must be provided in the Biographical Sketch and/or Current and Pending (Other) Support disclosures as part of the NOFO application. The inclusion of a PID will be optional until May 1, 2025, and mandatory thereafter.
 - We are continuously updating our <u>research security website</u> to stay up-to-date with all new regulations and policies.



- Freakonomics Radio Episodes on Fraud in Academia from January 2024
 - o Episode 572: Why Is There So Much Fraud in Academia?
 - Part 1 of 2: Some of the biggest names in behavioral science stand accused of faking their results. Last year, an astonishing 10,000 research papers were retracted. Freakonomics Radio talks to whistleblowers, reformers, and a co-author who got caught up in the chaos.
 - o Episode 573: Can Academic Fraud Be Stopped?
 - Part 2 of 2: Probably not the incentives are too strong. Scholarly publishing is a \$28 billion global industry, with misconduct at every level. But a few reformers are gaining ground.
